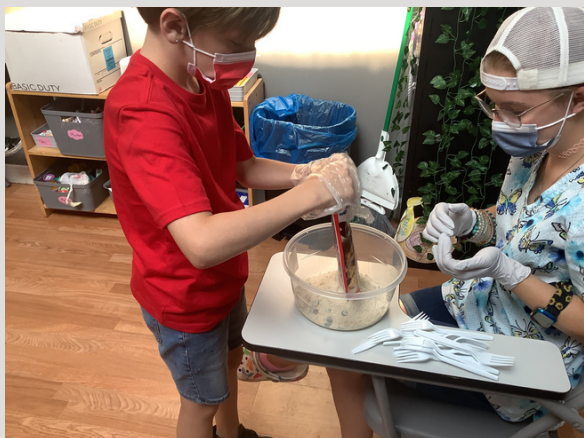
TODDLER CLASS
